Subject: Right of Way Easement

I. Objective.

To set forth the requirements for right of way easements for new services.

II. Policy

- A. The customers or prospective customers of the Cooperative shall grant an easement over lands owned by them for the purpose of constructing, operating and maintaining a distribution line or system to serve either the grantor or a prospective member. All requests shall be accompanied by a signed, executed right of way easement from 10 to 40 feet to be determined by the Staking Engineer.
- B. No development, plot or subdivision, shall be served unless proper right of way easements are executed for the total project.

III. Responsibility

- A. The Board of Trustees is responsible for a periodic review of this policy and shall approve all changes to the policy.
- B. The General Manager is responsible for the implementation of the policy.
